The Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation is pleased to announce the ROGER D. COLBERT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD. Grants are for \$500 to \$1,000 at the discretion of the judges for one academic year.

This package contains information and directions for applying to the Roger D. Colbert Memorial Scholarship Award.

ELIGIBILITY: All graduating high school seniors, residing in Illinois, who will be enrolling in their first year of full-time study at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational school who are related to an Illinois Jaycee member or JCI Senator are eligible for application.

SPONSORSHIP: Your sponsor is the member of the Illinois Jaycees or Illinois JCI Senator to whom you are related. Your sponsor is required to attach a letter to your application per the application instructions. If you are related to more than one member of the Illinois Jaycees or JCI Senator, they may sign a joint letter.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD: Recipients are based upon involvement, leadership roles, honors and awards, volunteer community service, employment, personal statements, financial statement, scholastic achievement and sponsor letter. Specific questions can be found on the application. Judging is done by an independent group with recipients being notified in April.

RESTRICTION: Applicants who have won an Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation Scholarship are not eligible for this award.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- All submissions must be typewritten or printed.
- Complete first page of application and include as your first page of application.
- No more than four(4) 8 1/2 X 11 sheets of paper may be used to answer all remaining questions, excluding financial statement page, sponsor letter, and transcript.
- Your name must be on the top of each sheet in your submission, along with a numbering system that states "page _____ of _____".
- Financial Statement is to be numbered and count as last numbered page.
- Neither the sponsor letter nor transcript need to be numbered.
- All applications should be completed in the order listed on the application and reference your responses to the outline identification headings and characters.
- Staple all sheets together at the upper left-hand corner.
- All applications must be received by MARCH 1st to be considered.

b) Write (100-300 words), in your own words, how you feel that the volunteer community service has had any impact on your personal life. Include pertinent experiences and activities with the Jaycee organization.

IX. FINANCIAL STATEMENT

You are required to complete and submit the attached Applicant's Financial Statement with your application submission. Estimated Income and Estimated Expense totals should be equal. Financial figures should be for first year of education only.

X. SPONSOR LETTER

You must include a letter from your Jaycee/JCI Senator sponsor stating why you meet the criteria for the scholarship award. Letter may also explain any special circumstances that the judges need to know when considering your application and your relationship to the applicant along with any personal information they wish to include. All letters are a maximum of one page.

XI. TRANSCRIPT

An official copy of your current high school transcript MUST be included. Transcript should indicate class rank, current academic average (minimum of 7 semesters) and any ACT/SAT scores. Transcription should be in a sealed envelope and attached at the end of your application.

Applicant's Financial Statement

The financial contribution of the applicant towards his/her own education is an important consideration in awarding this scholarship. The committee does not wish to penalize those students whose industry and careful planning have been a consideration in planning college attendance. Estimated Income and Estimated Expense totals should be equal. Financial figures should be for first year of education only.
